

1. Describe your position with your firm/organization/employer.

I serve as a senior associate in the firm's gaming practice. In this role I handle a variety of matters for gaming clients including: regulatory affairs, litigation and investigation, licensure and compliance, legal opinion drafting, etc.

2. How long have you been associated with/employed by this firm/organization? (If fewer than five years, please list your former relationships and positions.):

I joined my current firm in October 2022. Prior to this role I served as VP, Legal & Government Affairs for PrizePicks (a sports gaming/DFS company) from August 2021 – October 2022. Before PrizePicks I was an associate attorney at Morris, Manning & Martin, LLP for four years. In my role at Morris Manning I provided regulatory and licensing guidance to gaming companies and also counseled them during government or internal investigations. Prior to attending law school, I served as a junior executive for Sands China in the loyalty club and strategy department for twelve months from 2013-2014.
